### Iwokrama Tourism General Information Sheet

- a. Tours and bookings are subject to change as per guidelines from Government of Guyana
- b. Children 12 and under pay 50% meals
- c. Package deals cannot be customized. In the event that specific activities cannot be undertaken because of weather/recent or new COVID19 protocols etc, IIC will try its best to facilitate by offering other activities but there is no guarantee.
- d. Customized packages are also available at different costs.
- e. Activities may be shifted during the tour based on weather and logistics.
- f. Partial or full refunds will not be offered if activities cannot be or are not undertaken or if clients cancel tours. However, Iwokrama may consider refunds on a case by case basis and based on the circumstances.
- g. Clients must be willing to share boats and vehicles which have now been approved for 100% capacity. Clients who still insist on social distancing on transport will be expected to pay additional costs for extra vehicle/boats etc.
- 4. Prices of the tours exclude transport to and from the Iwokrama Rover Lodge. Some transport options are below:

- 5. Please be advised there are no guarantees for wildlife sightings. It is a privilege to see animals in their natural habitats and there are also some magnificent plant life. Our experienced guides will take every measure to ensure your experience is enjoyable. The only thing you can kill is time the only thing you can take is a photograph; the only thing you can leave is your footprints. Wildlife viewing is also seasonal.
- 6. Personal items to walk with:
  - b. Rubber boots or other waterproof footwear (We do not recommend wearing open footwear to walk in the rainforest)
  - c. Long trousers (2), preferably made of cotton-polyester mix
  - d. Long-sleeved shirt, sweater or jacket for cool evenings
  - e. T-shirts or short-sleeved shirts (3-4); light colours are preferable, darker colours can attract insects
  - f. Several changes of socks
  - g. Hat & sunscreen
  - h. Flip flops or trainers to wear when not on activities
  - i. Flashlight (headlamp if you want to see animal eye shine at night)
  - j. Insect repellent
  - k. Medication which you may require
  - l. Binoculars
  - m. A water container
  - n. Small Day Pack to take on activities
  - o. A Camera with flash.
  - p. Multiple face masks
  - q. Personal hygiene products such as liquid soap or sanitizers
- 7. Health and Hygiene:
  - 1. Iwokrama has a Hygiene and Health protocol for the management of all guests and visitors which visitors are encouraged to review before travel to Iwokrama please check on <u>www.iwokrama.org</u>
  - 2. Clients must provide proof of a negative COVID 19 test results to the Georgetown office before travelling to the field. We are accepting the Anti-body blood test valid for 3 days before travel.

# Also PCR or Antigen tests dated at least 5 days before travel to the interior.

- 3. We advise that if clients are experiencing fever, cough, sore throat or related symptoms that they postpone travel until they recover even with a negative COVID-19 test as this may cause distress and anxiety in other guests.
- 4. Clients will be subjected to a temperature check on arrival or in the case that they display typical symptoms (fever, cough, sneezing, sore throat) related to COVID-19
- 5. Clients must walk with their own face masks and must wear them at all times when in public spaces at Iwokrama – there is signage to guide you in this regard. Clients will not be permitted to enter the lodge, access public spaces or undertake tours unless they have a mask on. It is suggested that clients walk with more than one just in case one gets misplaced or damaged. Iwokrama will have regulation N 95 masks for sale at the River Lodge.
- 6. There will be adequate commercial sanitization facilities at strategic locations around the River Lodge but clients are encouraged to walk with their own personal sanitizers for their own personal comfort. These will also be on sale at the River Lodge.
- 7. Clients must provide any health insurance information to Iwokrama at the time of booking.
- 8. In the case of health emergencies or in the case of suspected COVID-19 cases:
  - 1. The client will be quarantined and will not be allowed to partake in any further activities;
  - 2. Iwokrama medex will undertake an initial assessment and if necessary, Iwokrama will provide transport to the nearest public health facility, unless the visitor has private insurance to cover the costs for other medical care / evacuation options.
- 9. The clients must agree to the above guidelines, information and terms before undertaking any Iwokrama tour. Iwokrama reserves the right to refuse service to any clients not wanting to follow these terms and guidelines.
